ERIK GIBELYOU is an active performer, teacher, and scholar living in Ann Arbor, MI. He performs frequently both as soloist and collaborator. As a member of Trio Ghidorah, Erik creates and performs arrangements and compositions for three guitars. The guitar trio proudly released their debut album, *Dances and Fantasies*, in March 2021. Dr. Gibelyou has performed and presented at the Dublin Guitar Symposium, Michigan Classical Guitar Workshop, and International Society of Bassists Convention. Erik teaches music courses and guitar at Saginaw Valley State University and Delta College. His Sound Community Music Series is a monthly music series taking place in Midland, MI, that features local musicians. He earned his Doctor of Musical Arts and Performer's Certificate at the Eastman School of Music in Rochester, NY. Erik studied guitar at Eastman with Nicholas Goluses and lute with Paul O'Dette, and he served as Director of Outreach for OSSIA New Music. Erik studied guitar (under Javier Calderon) and music theory at the University of Wisconsin-Madison. He studied with Brad DeRoche as an undergraduate at Saginaw Valley State University.
